Waste Management Unlimited Yard Waste

New for 2020 is TWO weeks of unlimited spring cleanup! Waste Management will collect unlimited containerized landscape waste at no charge to current customers the weeks of April 6th and April 13th. These dates are weather–dependent, so make sure to check the Township website closer to the date to ensure it has not been delayed. This collection will take place on your regular pickup day. This service is for unincorporated Warren Township road district residents (5-digit address). Collection requires that landscape waste be containerized in a Kraft-type paper bag not to exceed 50 lbs.; a rigid can not to exceed 32-gallons. Landscape waste must be placed at the curb or the edge of the road by 6:00 a.m.

Regular landscape waste collection through Waste Management's subscription service or sticker program will begin April 20th. Warren Township Road District Spring Leaf Collection

Weather permitting, the Road District will be offering a three week leaf collection service for unincorporated Warren Township road district residents (5-digit address). The collection dates will be Monday, April 6th and run through Friday, April 24th.

Placement of leaf piles follow the same guidelines as Waste Management's Fall leaf collection program. The collection will not be on a pre-scheduled day. Residents are asked to have their leaf piles out by 6:00 a.m. every Monday. Leaves will not be collected after April 24th.

Warren Township Road District Brush Removal Service

Our chipping equipment runs weekly, year-round, weather permitting. Pick up days are not scheduled due to not knowing how much brush has been placed out for pickup. Major guidelines to take notice of are as follows:

- The brush removal service is for residents who need to do a *little trimming and/or pruning* around their home.
- The service is not designed for residents who hire a contractor or landscaper to clear a lot, trim tree(s) or take down tree(s). If you hire a service it is the responsibility of the service provider to remove the brush.
- Any subdivision that has property that belongs to their homeowner's association (HOA), when trimming such property, it is the HOA's (contractor's) responsibility to remove the brush.
